## **Algiers Charter Schools Association Announces Post Super Bowl School Schedules**

*Regular Class Schedule on Monday, Early Dismissal on Tuesday*

New Orleans, La., Feb. 3, 2010 —Algiers Charter Schools Association (ACSA) Chief Executive Officer, Dr. Andrea Thomas-Reynolds, announced today that classes for all nine (9) ACSA network schools will operate on a regular school schedule on Monday, February 8<sup>th</sup>, following the Sunday Super Bowl game with the New Orleans Saints.

On Tuesday, February 9<sup>th</sup>, students will be dismissed at 12:30 p.m., after lunch, due to expected traffic delays in advance of the Saints Celebration Parade that afternoon. Students will be released to parents and regular bus service will be provided to students who need transportation to their homes.

“We are excited to witness history and cheer for our New Orleans Saints in their anticipated victory in the Super Bowl this Sunday,” said Dr. Thomas-Reynolds. “We must remember, however, that our children’s education takes precedence and that it is imperative that all students are in class on Monday, especially those taking standardized tests that day. On Tuesday, we’ll cheer the Saints on with our bands (*Walker, Karr, and Behrman*) marching in the Saints parade!”
